ANNUAL REPORT 2010-2011



1. On 12th August an Enrolment Campaign and a talk on 'NSS and its philosophy' were organized for the first year volunteers, which marked the beginning of the NSS activities of the academic year.
2. On 15th August Independence Day was celebrated:
 - i. The Secretary of our College Managing Committee Jb. K M Shamsudheen hoisted the flag and gave Independence Day Message. Principal, Staff members, NSS Volunteers and NCC Cadets were present during the flag hoisting Ceremony.
 - ii. A Poster presentation was organized in the campus on the same day to build awareness about the importance of Independence among students.
3. Observed Sadbhavana Day (20th August) and World Peace Day (21th September), discussions were held among volunteers.
4. On 24th September, NSS day was celebrated in our College by taking 'NSS DAY PLEDGE' and organized various activities.
5. On 27th September, the NSS Programme Officers participated in the Programme Officer's Conference at Baseliious College, Kottayam..
6. On 2nd October, in connection with Gandhi Jayanthi Celebrations, cleaning activities were taken up in the campus and NSS volunteers set up a bio-diversity plot in the campus.
7. Two NSS Volunteer Secretaries of our college participated in the three-day Volunteer Secretaries Camp from 8th to 10th October at St. Thomas College, Pala and they were selected the best volunteer secretaries.
8. In November, twenty NSS Volunteers participated in the Road User Satisfaction Survey 2010(RUSS 2010), a KSTP Project. The volunteers attended one day workshop at Union Christian College, Aluva before conducting survey.
9. On 1st December, NSS unit of our college organized a Red Ribbon Campaign and an awareness class on 'AIDS and its preventive measures' in connection with World AIDS day. Dr. Rincy from Medical College Hospital, Kolenchery was the resource person.

10. On 11th and 12th December 2010, two NSS volunteers participated in the Residential Leadership Training Programme organized by ALTIUS World Malayali Council at Aeli Hills, Thottumugham, Alwaye.
11. On 20th December, a Blood Donation Camp was organized in the campus in association with IMA, Aluva and 60 students donated blood on that day.
12. The seven day Special Camping Programme was organized from 23rd December to 29th December at Government U P School, Vazhakkulam. The theme of the camp was 'Healthy youth for healthy India'.
13. Twenty NSS volunteers participated in the three day camp at Tribal Colony, Ponganchuvad from 8th to 11th January.
14. On 26th January, NSS Volunteers, NCC Cadets and Staff members celebrated 62nd Republic Day. Our Principal, Dr. P A Fathima hoisted the flag and gave Republic day message.
15. On 8th February, a Blood Donation Camp was organized in the campus in association with IMA, Aluva and 42 students donated blood on that day.
16. Three NSS Volunteers participated in the three-day intercollegiate camp at M A College, Kothamangalam from 25/2/2011 to 27/2/2011.
17. The two day minicamp was conducted on 5th and 6th March in the college campus. Campus Beautification was the theme and the volunteers undertook cleaning activity.
18. On 13th March, the NSS Volunteers went for an environmental trip to Wagamonand they were accompanied by the Programme Officers.

SPECIAL CAMPING PROGRAMME

The seven day NSS Special Camp was held at Government U P School, Vazhakkulam, (Ward 1 of Vazhakkulam Gramapanchayat) from 23rd December to 29th December 2010. The camp successfully organized cleanliness drives in the ward, awareness programs, charity home visits etc. 101 NSS volunteers participated in the camp. Camp started on Friday, 23rd December with registration followed by ice breaking session and group dynamics.

We had planned the official inauguration on 24th December, but due to the demise of our former Chief Minister and MP, Sri K Karunakaran, the function was postponed to 26th December.

Different activities were conducted in the morning sessions of the camp. It included cleaning of Primary Health Centre, Vazhakkulam Grama Panchayat; maintenance of Panchayat road (Marampally to College) in front of our college and Government U P School, Tree plantation and cleaning the premises of Government U P School. The work at Health Centre, Vazhakkulam was inaugurated by Sri. T M Abdul Jabbar, President, Vazhakkulam Grama Panchayat on 26th December in the function presided over by our Principal Dr. P A Fathima. Smt. Shemi P M, Programme officer welcomed the gathering. Jb. The function started with NSS song and Programme Officer, Sri Jilesh V welcomed the audience. Valedictory address was given by Chief Guest Mr. Jayakumar, Sub Inspector of Police, Perumbavoor in

the function presided over by our Principal, Dr. P A Fathima. Smt. Rema, Headmistress, Govt U P School gave felicitation address. Camp review was given by Smt. Shemi P M, Programme Officer. After that prizes to best Volunteers and Campers were distributed.
