### **JUNE**

- On 21th, our cadets took part in the Yoga camp held at U C College on the international Yoga day.

### **JULY**

- On 14th , A speech competition was conducted by the NCC cadets as part of the Independence day program on the topic "INDIA: The Present And The Future”
