MES College Marampally is a Government Aided college affiliated to Mahatma Gandhi University, Kottayam, established in the year 1995. The College has been re-accredited by NAAC with A+ Grade (CGPA=3.38) which is the first ever highest grade in the State as per the revised process of accreditation. The campus is located in a rural area between the towns of Aluva and Perumbavoor, set in salubrious lush green surroundings in close vicinity of the river Periyar and proximate to Cochin International Airport.

The governance and the management of the college are anchored in the principles of Muslim Educational Society (Regd.), Calicut which is one of the largest minority educational agencies in Kerala. The establishment facilitated new directions in the field of higher education by offering a significant number of vocational (Model II) and technical programmes in tune with the demands of job market. The introduction of Vocational programmes in Logistics Management and in Animation and Graphic design when the UGC launched B. Voc. programmes bolster its mission statement "To promote higher and technical education". The larger enrolment of girls and minority students authenticate the institutional commitment towards equity and inclusion. Quality education is imparted to improve the life standards of people in general, minorities and backward classes in particular.

The college offers nineteen UG programmes, ten PG programmes and one Integrated M.Sc. programme in basic sciences - Chemistry and includes seven B. Voc. programmes. The Institution also gives due importance to integration of research and invention with the academic activities and ensures a dynamically symbiotic student-neighbourhood community relationship.

GENERAL ADMISSION RULES

Admission to various programmes are conducted as per the M.G. University rules in force. M.G. University conducts Centralised Allotment Process (CAP) for both UG and PG programmes to this effect and the candidates should register online for admission including the Management and Community quota seats. Candidates are advised to visit the M.G. University website (www.mgu.ac.in) for registration. The rules and eligibility of admission and Programmes offered by the college are as follows.

MERIT QUOTA

The merit seats of this college are Open quota seats, seats earmarked for SC/ST candidates in the aided programmes and the 50% of the total seats including seats reserved for SC/ST/SEBC of the Self-financing programmes.

COMMUNITY QUOTA

The seats under community quota are reserved for the students of Muslim community and the seats are filled on the basis of merit. The candidates who seek admission under community quota should directly apply to the college along with the CAP registration acknowledgement. No Community quota is earmarked in self-financing Programmes.

MANAGEMENT QUOTA

Twenty percentage seats of Aided Programmes and 50% seats of self-financing Programmes come under Management quota. These seats shall be filled by the management from candidates of their choice irrespective of the religion and caste provided they satisfy the eligibility conditions. Students seeking admission under management quota should submit Management quota form along with their application.

GENERAL RULES FOR COMMUNITY & MANAGEMENT QUOTAS

The application form along with intimation card and computer data sheet duly filled-in shall be send to the Principal so as to reach him on or before the date specified on the College Notice Board. In order to send the intimation cards under registered post, sufficient postal stamps must be affixed.

- In all subsequent enquiries regarding the admission, Registration number in the acknowledgment card and the programme applied for shall be quoted
- The students eligible for admission will be called for interview. An interview card will be sent to the applicant assigning the date of interview with the Principal. However, this card does not guarantee admission
- The applicant shall accompany Parent/Guardian during the interview. The applicant shall produce all the relevant documents mentioned below at the time of interview
 1. Transfer Certificate from School/College last attended
 2. Conduct Certificate from the Head of the Institution last attended
 3. Mark list of qualifying examination
 4. Community Certificate in the case of Scheduled caste/ Scheduled Tribe/Other Eligible Communities
 5. Migration Certificate of students who have passed from any other University / Board must be produced within a month, after enrollment
 6. Three passport size photographs

- Once the admission is secured by the candidate, he/she shall get enrolled after paying the full fees prescribed for admission.
- If the candidate fails to produce the relevant certificates or to remit the fees payable on the date of admission, they will lose their claim for admission.
- Non-receipt of intimation card will not be an excuse. In order to avoid this, the candidates are advised to verify the details regarding Admission list, the time and date of interview displayed on the College Notice Board.
- Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited. All the students and their parents must fill Anti-ragging affidavits at the time of admission.
- In order to ensure safety and security, the students must stay either with their Parents/Guardians or in the College hostels

FEES

The amount of fees payable at the time of admission will be displayed on the College Notice Board. For Aided Programmes, tuition fees and special fees as per government rules are applicable. For the self-financing Programmes, the tuition fees and special fees as per M.G. University norms. Students of self-financing Programmes should pay their semester fees at the beginning of each semester. Fees once paid will not be refunded under any circumstances. A student joining in between a semester will have to pay the entire fees for the term.

A student leaving a Programme mid-way is liable to pay the entire fee for the term. Every student shall pay the whole of fees and special fees at the time of admission.

BONUS MARKS

Bonus Marks of NCC will be awarded on the basis of NCC Certificate signed by the Director and issued by the Directorate of NCC. In respect of National Service Scheme (NSS) the bonus marks will be awarded on the basis of NSS Certificate issued by the competent authority. Bonus marks will be awarded to the Ex-servicemen applicants and widows and children of Jawans and Ex-service men seeking admission to the UG and PG Programmes.

Graduation in Biological Science Viz Zoology, Botany, Biotechnology, Biochemistry, Biological Techniques, Biophysics & Specimen preparation and Microbiology or Chemistry or MLT with not less than CGPA of 2.00 out of 4 in the group (Core + Open + Complementary).

M.A. English (SF)

Graduate with English under Part III (Model I, II & III) and all graduate in the faculties of Arts, Social Science, Science, Oriental Studies who have taken not less than three papers under compulsory English (out of a total of 300 marks) and not less 45% marks in Part III including Subsidiaries. The Stipulations of Part I English will not apply to B.A. English Model II and BA English Model III Communicative English (Three Main System). BA Communicative English (Single Main) can be

admitted on the basis of Part I English marks alone percentage of marks obtained under Part (BA/BSc) English or percentage of marks obtained under marks scored for the main/core/major (standardized to a total of 600 marks), in the case of those who have taken English as optional under Part III for the BA model I/II degree courses. The weightage will be 5% only in case of Model III BA Communicative English (Three main system).

M.Sc. Computer Science (Aided)

Graduation in Computer Application (BCA) or B.Sc. Degree with Mathematics/Computer Science/Electronics/IT as one of the subjects with not less than CGPA of 2.00 out of 4 in core group (Core + Complimentary + Open Course) or B.Tech Computer Science.

M.Sc. Physics (SF)

Graduation in Physics or Electronic Equipment maintenance with not less than CGPA of 2.00 out of 4 in the core group (Core + Complimentary + open courses).

MHRM (SF)

A pass in any Bachelor's Degree with not less than 55% marks in Science and Technology subjects and 50% marks in other subjects in the aggregate for all parts of examinations or a Master's Degree examination with 55% marks in aggregate.

M.Sc. Psychology (Aided)

BA or B.Sc. Psychology with not less than 50% marks.
