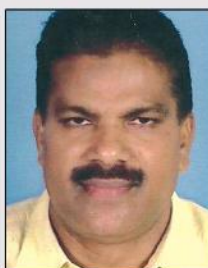

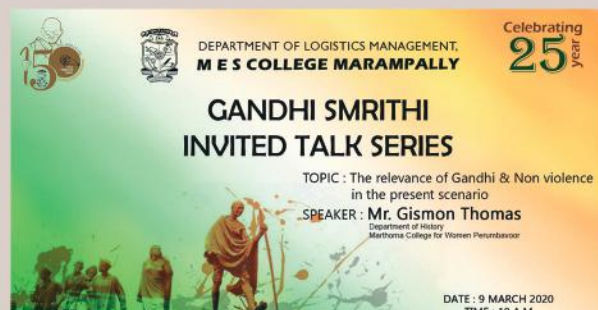
Computer System Assembling and OS Installation
