# **Decisions**

Similarly, the faculty growth plan must focus on the **research and development** and the faculty members must work for enough **publications/Patents/book chapters/research projects** (Poor contribution of research outcome has also affected the NIRF ranking also ).

The programmes conducted by the departments must **focus on two or three areas** and that should be streamlined in every years.

**Certificate programmes** to enrich the syllabus and thus to increase the **employability** shall be included in the action plan. The departments must strengthen the **Industry-academia linkages** and **consultancy services**. The analysis of SSR demands an **increase in the usage of library** by the students and faculty members.

The meeting decided to circulate a copy of the peer team report among the departments and suggested to include Peer team recommendations to include in formulating the action plan of the Departments.
