

Decisions and Actions taken

Agenda No. 1: Activities to be conducted in the current Academic Year

As the third cycle of accreditation period extends only until 27 March 2024, IQAC needs to proactively identify and oversee the tasks to be completed by the Management, faculty, and students. It was decided to review the recommendations of NAAC in the 3rd cycle and ensure their implementation.

- In the interest of enhancing overall quality, significant emphasis should be placed on students' academic performance. IQAC will take the lead in improving student outcomes. Departments are instructed to identify struggling students and provide targeted support, including remedial classes, focused discussions, and peer-assisted learning.
- Each department is required to submit an action plan for the academic year 2022-23,





incorporating the recommendations provided by IQAC based on the previous year's activities.

- IQAC will oversee the performance appraisal of faculty members. Faculty must submit self-assessment reports at the conclusion of each academic year to IQAC.
- File verification related to CMC 2021-22 will commence on Monday (22-08-2022), and a staff orientation on AQAR and NAAC criteria will be held on 23-08-2022.
- It was decided to reinforce the Quality Circle by nominating students from all classes. An interaction with the Quality Circle students is to be arranged promptly.
- The proposal for an NAAC seminar must be submitted by 30-08-22. Pending programs, such as Faculty Development Programs, orientation for non-teaching staff, and NAAC orientation for junior colleges, need to be finalized before 30-08-2022.

Agenda No.2 Add on/ Certificate Courses

Considering that the syllabus revision for UG programs was last conducted in 2017, many program syllabi have become outdated. To keep students abreast of current developments in their fields, all departments are instructed to organize add-on programs.

- Each department must identify suitable ADD-ON Courses, particularly for first-year students. Collaborations with relevant agencies and resource persons should be established to facilitate the conduct of these add-on programs. Classes for add-on courses can be scheduled on week days by adjusting the department timetable.
- PG students are encouraged to enroll in NPTEL courses. Faculty members are also urged to register for NPTEL courses and serve as mentors. Students scoring 80% or more in assignments will receive fifty percent of the examination fee as an incentive.

Agenda No. 3 Research Grants: Proposal submission

Given the limited availability of research proposal funding from external agencies, the college management has decided to provide financial assistance to teachers based on evaluations of their research proposals.

Decisions and Actions taken

Agenda No. 1 Department level preparations for the next cycle of NAAC accreditation

As the third cycle of accreditation period is only upto 27 March 2024, all the departments must organize different activities/programmes under seven criteria of NAAC for A++ grade with high score. IQAC coordinator, Dr. Jasmine P M described in detail the recommendations of the last cycle of accreditation and pointed out the weakness of the institution. To prepare the college for the next NAAC visit departments are directed to implement the following things

- As the SSR format is revised by NAAC with reduced QIF and number of matrices, HoDs must go through all the criterions in the revised manual. For the smooth conduct and documentation of programs, HoDs must allocate at least one faculty for each criterion. During the file verification in connection with CMC 2021-22, it is found that documents of most of the departments are not upto date. All the departments are directed to complete the pending works within fifteen days for the next verification of IQAC along with Principal
- Departments are directed to conduct more add-on, certificate and value added programs and enroll maximum students. Courses must be organized in such a manner that each student will get three certificates after the completion of threeyear Degree course. Departments are directed to promote students to take up internships, field projects etc. to promote experiential learning. Departments must ensure that feedback on curriculum from employers, alumni and students are collected for analysis and actions
- All the departments must conduct FDPs of minimum three days' duration. HoDs are requested to submit the updated result on or before 29 July 2022
- All the faculty members are directed to take special interest in publishing papers in SCI/Scopus/UGC Care Journals. Teachers who are qualified may apply for guide



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
ship from parent University or other institutions. Faculty members must submit research proposals to different funding agencies like DST, ICSSR, KSCSTE etc. Due importance must be given to extension activities by incorporating more students.

- Our Library is having many e journal subscriptions. All the department may check the availability of e-resources in the concerned subject and if any shortages are to be informed to Principal. To promote library usage by students, allot one hour for library to all PG students
- All the faculty members are directed to attend Professional development programs. Teachers can avail 50% of the registration fee after submitting the attendance certificate and fee paid details. While conducting different programs, importance may be given to sessions on Gender Equity, Constitutional obligations, human values, rights, duties and responsibilities of citizens. Decided to celebrate the 75th year of independence under the leadership of NCC/NSS/Physical Education by conducting 75 different programs
- Code of conduct programs for students, teaching and non-teaching staff are to be organized

Agenda No.2 E-Content Development by faculty

During the COVID pandemic, many of the faculty members developed e-content by utilizing different software and studio facility of MES College Marampally. After the pandemic, the faculty members are not giving due importance on e-content development. All the teachers must develop at least one e-content before 31 August 2022

- Centralized Student Satisfaction Survey: To ensure a comprehensive assessment, the Student Satisfaction Survey for 2021-22 will be centrally conducted using our state-ofthe-art computer lab. All departments and staff are urged to update information on our college website.
- Empowering Student Quality Circles: We're convening a meeting of our student quality





- circle to collaboratively plan and execute student-focused activities. Their input is invaluable.
- Strengthening Tutorial and Mentoring: We're committed to enhancing our tutorial and mentoring system. Regular meetings with student groups will foster a supportive learning environment. We're encouraging students to participate in field trips and internships to promote experiential learning.

Decisions and Actions taken

Agenda No. 1: Accreditation module of Linways

To simplify the submission of AQAR 2022-23, it has been decided that all faculty members must enter their data into the Linways EXAT module. To ensure the accuracy and effectiveness of the accreditation module, all IQAC members, in collaboration with Dr. Jaseena K U, the faculty member responsible for the accreditation module, have verified all the modules under the STAFF section.

After entering sample data under each heading, it was identified that certain categories need modification. Consultation will be sought from the Department regarding





consultancy, and publications will be further categorized into journal publications, book chapters, and conference proceedings. Additionally, it has been decided to make the inclusion of dates mandatory for publications.

Agenda No.2 Documentation of SSR (IV cycle)

- As the validity of the third cycle of accreditation extends only until March 27, 2023, it is imperative that we promptly prepare the SSR documents to ensure the submission of the SSR by September 2023.
- It has been determined that the documentation work for SSR will commence in the first week of March. Simultaneously, documentation work for AQAR 22-23 will be undertaken.
- The benchmark for quantitative metrics was discussed, emphasizing the need to pay special attention to those areas where maximum points have not been attained.
- Proper management of reports detailing all activities conducted by various cells/departments is crucial. All reports and accompanying photos are to be uploaded into the Linways EXAT module.
- Furthermore, it has been resolved to visit SAFI Institute of Advanced Studies, Vazhayoor, recently accredited with an A+ by NAAC, with participation from all IQAC members.

A proposal for a National Online Faculty Development Program on MOODLE, in collaboration with the Guru Angad Dev Teaching Learning Centre (a center under the Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission on Teachers and Teaching, MHRD, Government of India), is to be promptly submitted. The responsibility for overseeing the program has been assigned to Lt. Ibrahim Salim M, Assistant Professor in the Department of Computer Applications.
