REPORT OF CULTURAL FORUM: 2020-21

As part of the activities of cultural forum, a webinar on *“Online education, opportunities and values”* were conducted on 9th October 2020 at 7.30 pm through Google Meet. The resource person of the day was Dr. Kunju Muhammed Pulavath. Principal Dr. Ajims P Muhammed presided over the meeting. Adv. Abul Hassan (Secretary, College Management), Dr. Manzur Ali, (Vice Principal), Dr. Rafeekamol (HOD, Department of Commerce) and several teaching and non-teaching staff and 116 students from various departments attended the webinar.
