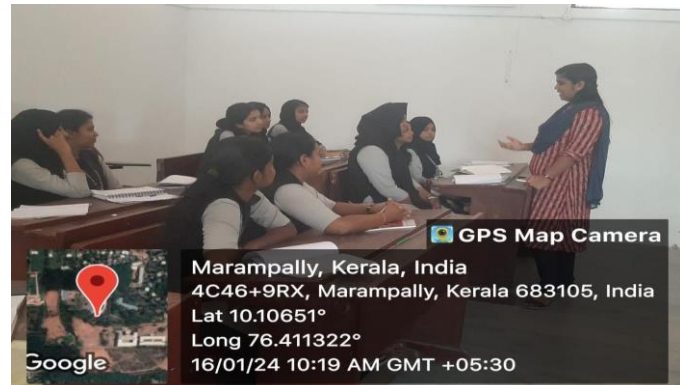
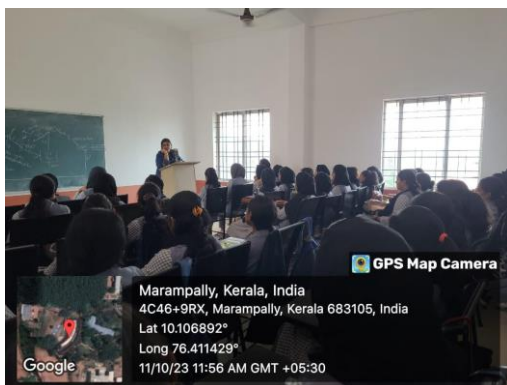
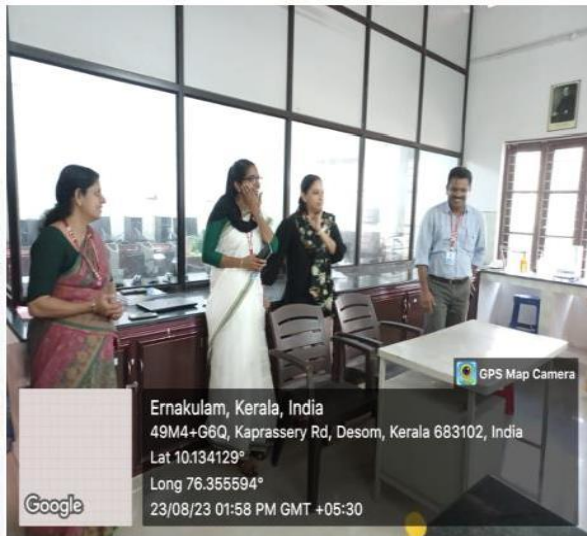

She also highlighted 'standardized tests' or 'entrance exams' to go abroad, like TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language) IELTS (International English Language Testing System), GRE (Graduate Record Examination), SAT (Scholastic Assessment Test), etc.

Ms. Raslana, MSc Microbiology of the 2018-2020 batch, interacted with the UG students of the department on 11th October 2023. She has shared her experiences of many opportunities she met. It included both curricular and co-curricular activities. She made the students, especially the girls, more confident about their careers.
