- The Cell helps the college office in collecting SC/ST students' data and ensures their receipt of stipend/scholarship for both hostellers and day scholars.
- The Committee was reconstituted and formed in the new format from June 2022.

- The stipend to all SC/ST students are credited to their respective bank accounts. All students who apply, receive it in time.
- The college had conducted seminars, orientation and training sessions, and remedial coaching in the past years.
- Diploma in Computer Application (DCA) course is given for free to 30 dalit students every year
- The PTA Book Bank working at the college library gives opportunity to SC students to avail books for free
- Active Participation of the SC/ST in sports

- Physical Education Teachers are the coach for these students in Wrestling, Judo, Taekondo, Jujitsu and Kurash.
- The most benefited from 'Pragathi', 'Computer Padasala' and Yoga Class are the dalit students at the Govt. UP School.
- Here, in the college we have SC/STs among the staff. All are given equal treatment at all levels.

COMPLAINT REGISTRATION PORTAL

A grievance redressal portal for registering complaints is working good at the college website by the SC/ST Cell. Students, Teaching Staff and Non-Teaching Staff can file their complaints through the portal. The complaints received will be kept confidential and the Portal will be jointly managed with the Grievance Redressal Cell of the college.

ORIENTATION PROGRAMME
